

DIRECTIONS TO THE TEST SITE

FROM THE OHIO TURNPIKE EAST OF EXIT 152: Go right from the toll booth and follow the signs to Rt. 10 and Oberlin. Take Rt. 10 West and it will merge into Rt. 20 West. Follow Rt. 20 to the intersection with Rt. 58. Take Rt. 58 South through Wellington to New London-Eastern Rd. New London-Eastern Rd. is 7.8 miles past the McDonalds in Wellington. Turn right (west) and follow New London-Eastern Rd. to the test site, on the left between Baker Rd. and Quarry Rd.

FROM THE TURNPIKE WEST OF EXIT 91: Leave I-80 at Exit 91 to avoid Cedar Point traffic. Head South on Rt. 53 to Rt. 20. Take Rt. 20 East to Rt. 511. Follow Rt. 511 South (right) to New London-Eastern Rd. Turn East (left) to the test site between Baker Rd. and Quarry Rd.

FROM I-71 SOUTH: Take I-71 North past Ashland and exit at Rt. 301. Take Rt. 301 North to Rt. 224. Go west on Rt. 224 to Rt. 58. Go North on Rt. 58 to New London-Eastern Rd. Turn West (left) and follow it to the test site between Baker Rd. and Quarry Rd.

FROM I-480 EAST: Take I-480 West to Rt. 10. Follow Rt. 10 and it will merge into Rt. 20 West. Follow the remainder of directions under OHIO TURNPIKE EAST.

FROM I-90 EAST OR WEST: Take I-90 West/East, west of Cleveland to Rt. 58 South and exit. Follow remainder of directions in OHIO TURNPIKE EAST

FROM PA-OHIO TURNPIKE EAST: Follow I-76 West to State Rt. 224 West. Take St. Rt. 224 to St. Rt. 58. Go North on Rt. 58 to New London-Eastern Rd. Turn west (left) there and follow it to the test site, between Baker Rd. and Quarry Rd.

FROM THE HOTELS IN AMHERST: Follow Rt., 58 South through Wellington. See OHIO TURNPIKE EAST directions above.

FROM THE HOTEL IN ASHLAND: Go East on Rt. 250 to Rt. 89. Turn left (north) on Rt. 89, cross over Rt. 42 and continue north. Rt. 89 runs into Rt. 58. Go North on Rt. 58. When you cross into Lorain County, New London-Eastern Rd is the next road. Turn left (west) and follow it to the test site on the left between Baker and Quarry Roads.

YAHOO DIRECTIONS ADDRESS: 48799 New London Eastern Rd, Wellington, OH 44090. This is the closest numeric address we can guesstimate. You should still read the directions above.

ENTRY FEE \$75.00 (TD) or \$125.00 (TDX)

Make checks and money orders payable (in U.S. Funds) to CABTC and mail to the Test Secretary. You will be notified by phone or email within 24 hours after the draw. Please include either or both so that I can contact you. Entries need to be on an official AKC form, signed and include the entry fee.

DRAWING OF ENTRIES - Entries shall be accepted up until the official closing date, even though the advertised limits have been reached. Please do not send an entry that requires a signature for acceptance. I am not always at home! Entries will be drawn by the Test Secretary on **Thursday April 26 at 7 PM** at her home. The drawing shall be completely random among all entries received, whichever test is entered. Preference is given in the TD test to those dogs who have not yet earned a TD and in the TDX test to those who have not earned a TDX. When the advertised limit has been drawn, all remaining entries, subject to the same preferences set forth above, shall be assigned a position on the Alternate List corresponding to the order in which they were drawn. In the event that either test does not fill a TDX can be exchanged for 2 TD's and vice versa.

ENTRY REFUNDS: Entries who pass an AKC approved test after the closing date of this test may withdraw from this test with full refund provided the test secretary is notified before the test date and there is an alternate to replace the entry. Call me as soon as you know! Those who decline to be placed on the alternate list shall have their entry fees returned or destroyed in my shredder. Any dog who makes the draw but cannot run may also have their fees returned only if an alternate competes in their place.

ENTRY FEES SHALL NOT BE REFUNDED in the event that a dog is absent, disqualified, excused by a Veterinarian or Judge, or barred from competition by action of the Show Committee. Exhibitors are governed by rules and regulations of the AKC and local ordinances. The well-being of the exhibitors, dogs and spectators is of paramount importance. In the event it is necessary to cancel or stop the event before completion, no refund of entry will be made.

DRAWING FOR TRACKS: The Judges will assemble the participants in the test site parking lot for a drawing by lot for the track number of each participant. **The time for each draw will be stated in judging program.** The order in which tracks are run and the number of each track shall be determined by the Tracking Judges. Judging will begin as soon as possible after the draws.

ALTERNATE ENTRIES: If an accepted entry is absent on the day of the test, it shall be the responsibility of the Test Secretary to determine if any alternates are present. Alternates will draw for available tracks based on their place on the alternate list. If no alternates are present the judges will designate someone to draw for the absent dog, who may run the track if it arrives before the track is scheduled to be run. If it does not arrive by then it will be marked absent.

PRIZES - Each passing team shall receive a memento of their achievement

INCIDENTALS: Please join us for lunch following the test. There will be a portapotty at the site. The cover varies from moderately short to waist-high, fairly rough, mostly flat with a few ponds. The woods are mild to thick in density. According to AKC regulations, you must keep your dogs on leash at all times and, of course, please pick up your poop if it is in a place someone might find it later!

In consideration of the acceptance of this entry and of the holding of this event and of the opportunity to have the dog judged and to win prizes, ribbons, or trophies, I (we) agree to hold the AKC, the event-giving club, their members, directors, governors, officers, agents, superintendents or event secretary and the owner and/or lessor of the premises and any provider of services that are necessary to hold this event and any employees or volunteers of the aforementioned parties, and any AKC approved judge, judging at this event, harmless from any claim for loss or injury which may be alleged to have been caused directly or indirectly to any person or thing by the act of this dog while in or about the event premises or grounds or near any entrance thereto, and I (we) personally assume all responsibility and liability for any such claim; and I (we) further agree to hold the aforementioned parties harmless from any claim for loss, injury or damage to this dog.

INSTRUCTIONS

- 1. (Variety) if you are entering a dog of breed in which there are varieties for show purposes, please designate the particular variety you are entering, i.e., Cocker Spaniel (solid color black, ASCOB, parti-color), Beagles (not exceeding 13 in., over 13 in. but not exceeding 15 in.), Dachshunds (longhaired, smooth, wirehaired), Collies (rough, smooth), Bull Terriers (colored, white), Manchester Terriers (standard, toy), Chihuahuas (smooth coat, long coat), English Toy Spaniels (King Charles and Ruby, Blenheim and Prince Charles), Poodles (toy, miniature, standard).
2. The following categories of dogs may be entered and shown in Best of Breed competition: Dogs that are Champions of Record and dogs which, according to their owners' records, have completed the requirements for a championship, but whose championships are unconfirmed. The showing of unconfirmed Champions in Best of Breed competition is limited to a period of 90 days from the date of the show where the dog completed the requirements for a championship.
3. (Event Class) Consult the classification in this premium list. If the event class in which you are entering your dog is divided, then, in addition to designating the class, specify the particular division of the class in which you are entering your dog, i.e. age division, color division, weight division.
4. A dog must be entered in the name of the person who actually owned it at the time entries for an event closed. If a registered dog has been acquired by a new owner it must be entered in the name of its new owner in any event for which entries closed after the date of acquisition, regardless of whether the new owner has received the registration certificate indicating that the dog is recorded in his/her name. State on entry form whether transfer application has been mailed to the AKC. (For complete rules, refer to Chapter 11, Section 3.)
5. Mixed Breed dogs entering classes for Agility, Obedience, and Rally trials should mark Breed as "All-American Dog/Mixed Breed." Sire and Dam information shall remain blank for mixed breed entrants.
