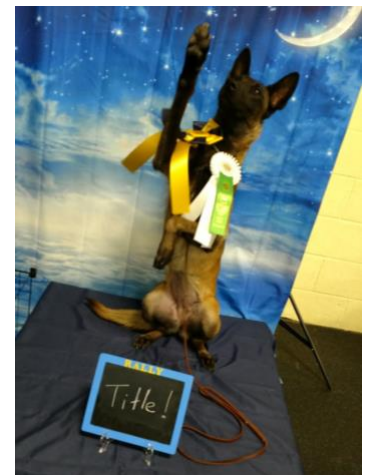

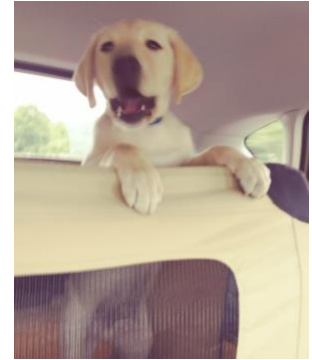

Deb's Home-Brewed, Dog-Safe Weed Killer: (Submitted by Deb Kaufman)

1 gallon vinegar, 5% Acidity (You can find higher acidity at horticultural supply, but not necessary).
2 1/2 c. Salt
2/3 c. Dawn dish detergent

Heat the vinegar on the stove, add salt. Stir until salt is completely dissolved. Pour into a yard sprayer. Add Dawn. Stir to combine.

Spray the leaves (not roots) so they are coated with the solution. The leafier the better!

Works best when plants are good and thirsty!



Editor's note: I tried this myself with superb results, especially on broadleaf weeds. Within a day they were crispy critters! Note that this solution will kill anything green, so spray carefully around grass and plants you want to keep! The photo above is from a weed in one of my beds about 24 hours after I sprayed it! The hand-pump sprayers (Home Depot) work great for applying this! MH
