**TESTING OFFERED**

ACT 1 (2 courses) and ACT 1J (2 courses) will be offered in the morning with ACT  
2 (2 courses) and ACT 2J (2 courses) offered immediately following.

In the AKC ACT program, owners/agents may register their dogs for any jump  
height. All height divisions will be offered in both ACT 1, ACT 1J and ACT 2 and  
ACT 2J. Dogs can be measured at the event – this is NOT an official  
measurement. Running order will be tall to small. Electronic timing will be used.

Move Ups (title in ACT 1, move up to ACT 2; title in ACT1J, move up to ACT 2J)  
will be allowed. Exhibitors are not required to complete ACT 1 or ACT 1J before  
competing in ACT 2 or ACT 2J, although titling in ACT 2 or ACT 2J prohibits  
exhibitors from competing in ACT 1 or ACT 1J; although ACT and ACT Jumpers  
operate separately (you can complete in ACT 1 and ACT 2J at the same time, of  
vice versa). Please remember that if you do not register in advance, day of show  
entry fees apply to move your dog up to ACT 2 and ACT 2J.

**DOG ELIGIBLE TO ENTER**

This trial is open to all dogs FIFTEEN (15) months of age or older that have not  
achieved an AKC agility title. Registration in American Kennel Club or AKC Limited  
Registration, Purebred Alternative Listing/Indefinite Listing Privileges (PAL/ILP), or  
AKC Canine Partners listing number or approved Foundation Stock Service (FSS)  
breeds is NOT required but is required to receive AKC title certificate.

Females in season, aggressive dogs, or dogs suffering from an injury, or illness  
which may affect the dog's physical or mental performance may not participate.  
No dog shall compete if it is sutured, bandaged, or has any visible wounds.

**Staging Area** Staging area will include crating, warm-up and waiting area, as well as the secretary table for check-ins and posting of running order and results.

The ACT **MANDATORY Handler's Briefing** will take place in the morning and shall include sport's basics like how to fill out an AKC entry form, check-in at the ring, how to take your dog in and out of ring, handling your dog while being judged and other skills that will help you move on to AKC agility trials with your dog. **NO DOGS** are to be present during the Handler's Briefing.

A **warm-up area** will be available consisting of ONE regulation jump for the purpose of warming up your dog. The warm-up area is not for training or relieving of the dog.

The Cleveland All-Breed Training Club, Inc. reserves the right to decline entries for cause and

may remove any dog on account of aggression. No one shall have any recourse or claim against the Cleveland All-Breed Training Club, Inc. or any official thereof.

**All dogs must be on leash** at all times. Dogs must enter and exit the agility test with the leash attached to the collar or harness, including when waiting in the search area before and after the search. Collars must not have any tags or anything hanging from them when participating in ACT testing.

### REFUNDS

**No entry fee** will be refunded if the event cannot open or be completed by reason of riots, civil disturbances, fire, an act of God, public emergency, act of a public enemy, or any other cause beyond the control of the organizing committee. No entry fee will be refunded in the event a dog is absent, disqualified, excused, or barred from competition by the action of the Event Committee. Dogs pulled after closing because of injury or other medical condition may be eligible for a partial refund with a veterinarian letter.

**Bitches in season** will be refunded their entry fee minus \$5.00 per class entered to cover AKC and CABTC registration fees. Notification in writing must be given to the trial secretary with a letter from a veterinarian no later than one half hour prior to the start of the first class of the day of the trial.

**Crating space** will be available. The event site requires a tarp to be placed on the floor underneath your crates.

**Exhibitors are responsible** for cleaning up after their dog(s). **From the West (via Ohio Turnpike):** Take the Ohio Turnpike and get off at the I-480 exit. Take I-480 East to Rt. 176 North.

**From Rt. 176 North:** The very next exit is Spring Rd/Hinckley Parkway. Turn right onto Spring Rd/Hinckley.

**From Spring Rd./Hinckley Parkway:** Shortly after turning onto Spring Rd/Hinckley Parkway, they separate into 2 roads. Stay left and turn left unto Spring Rd. (Hinckley Pkwy continues straight ahead). Spring Rd dead-ends at Van Epps (at the stop sign). Make a very slight right turn unto Van Epps. ## COVID INFORMATION AND RELEASE

Returning to trialing depends on having a thorough understanding of the Club's new protocols to help safeguard participants, judges, and volunteers. We will need volunteers more than ever and so we have figured out ways for our workers to stay apart and reduce the need to touch papers or surfaces.

We invite you to participate in our trials and will require you to follow these rules to best protect everyone present:

**REFUNDS: Please stay home if you feel ill or if you have been exposed to someone with the virus. We actively encourage you to stay home until you have had no Covid-19 symptoms (fever, cough, etc.) for 10-14 days. If you experience illness, you may contact the trial secretary for a 100% refund.**

In the meantime, please study these rules carefully before you enter our trial to make sure you understand the new requirements and are willing to abide by them.

- **MASKS: Masks will be worn over the nose and mouth at all times** while in the building. The judge will also be wearing a mask. Please bring your own mask. Should you forget, masks can be purchased on site.
- **SOCIAL DISTANCING:** Practice social distancing at all times. In general, please avoid congregating to every extent possible.
- **SANITIZATION:** Wash hands frequently and thoroughly. Use hand sanitizers positioned liberally throughout the building. Avoid touching dogs that are not your responsibility. We will clean all commonly touched surfaces regularly throughout the trial and again at the end of the day.
- **CRATING:** We will be doubling the crating area from previous trials. You are also may crate in your car. Please maintain social distancing from other exhibitors. Family units may crate together. Chairs can be left with your crate as usual.
- **PARKING:** Be considerate when loading and unloading your car to allow for appropriate social distancing. If crating from your car please allow for social distancing.
- **FOOD: Please pack your own food and beverages. No food or drink will be available at the trial (except for volunteers and judges).**
- **SPECTATORS:** Only workers or exhibitors entered in the trial are allowed in the building. We encourage your family members to stay home but if there is a reason a family member needs to accompany you - we trust your judgment.
- **CHAIRS:** Please bring your own chair and avoid sitting anywhere else.
- **RIBBONS:** Ribbons will not be self-serve at this trial.
- **CHECK-IN:** Please bring your own pen for check in and maintain social distancing.
