TESTING OFFERED

The **AKC Temperament Test (ATT)** was developed to bring focus and provide a meaningful evaluation to assess the temperament of our canine companions.

The ATT tests how a dog reacts to a variety of stimuli. Desirable traits are that the dog will be emotionally stable, inquisitive, cooperative, appropriately social for its breed, biddable and demonstrates the ability to recover from a startling situation in a reasonable amount of time.

Undesirable traits are fear, shyness, lack of cooperation and an inability to recover from unfamiliar or unexpected situations. Examples of undesirable behaviors include being afraid of friendly strangers or unfamiliar stimuli, obsessive barking, and aggression.

In the ATT, dogs are tested in 6 categories of stimuli that include:

- Social
- Auditory
- Visual
- Tactile
- Proprioceptive (motion)
- Unexpected stimulus

Each dog needs **two** qualifying scores under two different judges in order to achieve an ATT title.

DOG ELIGIBLE TO ENTER

Please refer to the AKC website for eligibility standards for each test. In order to gain the title on successful qualifications, dogs must be registered in American Kennel Club or AKC Limited Registration, Purebred Alternative Listing/Indefinite Listing Privileges (PAL/ILP), or AKC Canine Partners listing number or approved Foundation Stock Service (FSS) breeds is required.

Females in season, or dogs suffering from an injury, or illness which may affect the dog's physical or mental performance may not participate. No dog shall compete if it is sutured, bandaged, or has any visible wounds. Aggressive dogs, including but not limited to dogs that have been disqualified and not reinstated by the AKC, as well as any dog that has been deemed aggressive, dangerous and/or vicious by any governmental entity are not eligible for entry.

ENTRY FEES

*an entry is defined as a single test by a single dog, in a single class.

ATT entry (*pre-registration*)\$30 (1 test); \$50 (2 tests)
Each ATT entry (*day of event registration*).....\$35 (1 test) \$60 (2 tests)
Day of testing entries accepted before 11:00 AM only

RIBBONS, AWARDS, AND PRIZES

A qualifying ribbon will be awarded to all dog and handler teams completing a run within qualifying parameters.

Any exhibitor whose dogs and/or children create an unnecessary disturbance or repeatedly engage in unsafe or disruptive behavior may, at the discretion of the trial committee, be asked to leave the show site. In such case, no refund of any fees paid will be made. The Cleveland All-Breed Training Club, Inc. and its agents, employees, etc., will assume no responsibilities for any loss, damage or injury sustained by exhibitors or handlers, or to any of their dogs or property and further assumes no responsibility for injury to children. The

Cleveland All-Breed Training Club, Inc. reserves the right to decline entries for cause and may remove any dog on account of aggression. No one shall have any recourse or claim against the Cleveland All-Breed Training Club, Inc. or any official thereof. **All dogs must be on leash** at all times.

REFUNDS

No entry fee will be refunded if the event cannot open or be completed by reason of riots, civil disturbances, fire, an act of God, public emergency, act of a public enemy, or any other cause beyond the control of the organizing committee. No entry fee will be refunded in the event a dog is absent, disqualified, excused, or barred from competition by the action of the Event Committee.

UNEXPECTED STIMULUS

- Approach, carries box & objects

- Approach briskly - unusual clothing

CLEVELAND ALL-BREED TRAINING CENTER RULES

- **Plastic, tarp or mat must be placed under crates & ex-pens.**
- **NO Smoking inside the building.**
- **NO bitches in season permitted.**

DIRECTIONS TO THE TRIAL SITE

From the West (via Ohio Turnpike): Take the Ohio Turnpike and get off at the I-480 exit. Take I-480 East to Rt. 176 North.

From Rt. 176 North: The next exit is Spring Rd/Hinckley Parkway. Turn right onto Spring Rd/Hinckley.

From Spring Rd./Hinckley Parkway: Shortly after turning onto Spring Rd/Hinckley Parkway, they separate into 2 roads. Stay left and turn left unto Spring Rd. (Hinckley Pkwy continues straight ahead). Spring Rd dead-ends at Van Epps (at the stop sign). Make a very slight right turn unto Van Epps. The next street is Hayes Dr. Turn left unto Hayes Drive. 210 Hayes Drive is the 2nd building on your left.

From the East (via Ohio Turnpike): Get off at the I-77 exit. Follow the signs to I-77. Take I-77 North to I-480 West. Immediately get off at the Rt. 176 North/Brookpark exit. Stay on Rt. 176 N and then follow above directions for "From Rt. 176 North".

From the South (and hotels): Take I-77 North to I-480 West. Immediately get off at the Rt. 176 off at the Rt. 176 North/Brookpark exit. AGREEMENT

I (we) agree that the club holding this event has the right to refuse this entry for cause which the club shall deem sufficient. I (we) certify and represent that the dog entered is not a hazard to persons or other dogs. In consideration of the acceptance of this entry and of the holding of this event and of the opportunity to have the dog judged and to win prizes, ribbons, or trophies, I (we) agree to hold the AKC, the event-giving club, their members, directors, governors, officers, agents, superintendents or event secretary and the owner and/or lessor of the premises and any provider of services that are necessary to hold this event and any employees or volunteers of the aforementioned parties, and any AKC approved judge, judging at this event, harmless from any claim for loss or injury which may be alleged to have been caused directly or indirectly to any person or thing by the act of this dog while in or about the event premises or grounds or near any entrance thereto, and I (we) personally assume all responsibility and liability for any such claim; and I (we) further agree to hold the aforementioned parties harmless from any claim of loss, injury or damage to this dog.
