As you may know, through the great work of Annette Pederson and her committee, the Club has been researching the possibility of becoming a 501(c)(4) non-profit. A 501(c)(4) organization has a substantially decreased tax burden (generally speaking the Club would not pay federal income tax except for earnings on our investments and sales from the "store"), but is different from a 501(c)(3) in that contributions are not tax deductible. As the Club paid well over \$20,000 in taxes last year, the goal is to significantly reduce this by obtaining 501(c)(4) status.

The Board has approved the preparation of the IRS paperwork, which requires us to provide our Mission Statement. The 501(c)(4) criteria looks at an organization's goals/purpose of bettering their communities and the common good. In this regard, the Board has accepted the Tax-Exempt Committee's recommendation that we make some slight tweaks to our Mission Statement to highlight who we meet this criteria. Immediately below is our current Mission Statement (can be found on the website) and then below that are the proposed edits, with the new language in **red**:

Proposed Mission Statement or Statement of Purpose – changes in parenthesis

- To promote the training of dogs and handlers.
- To disseminate the latest knowledge regarding **responsible dog ownership and** dog training.



- To conduct classes **for the community** focused on the training of dogs and **education of** their handlers.
- To encourage **and provide for** the training and **education** of instructors & judges **that advance the interests of the American Kennel Club and its companion and performance events.**
- To hold & support obedience/**rally** trials, agility trials, **scent trials**, tracking tests, sanctioned matches and other activities **for the community** under the rules and regulations of the American Kennel Club.
- To promote cooperation and **the AKC Code of Sportsmanship** among members in the training and exhibition of dogs.

The changes to the Mission Statement will be on the agenda for the Membership Meeting on May 18<sup>th</sup>, but we wanted to circulate now so everyone had the chance to review and consider in advance. The goal is to finalize the changes at the Membership Meeting so that we can proceed to file the IRS paperwork in June.

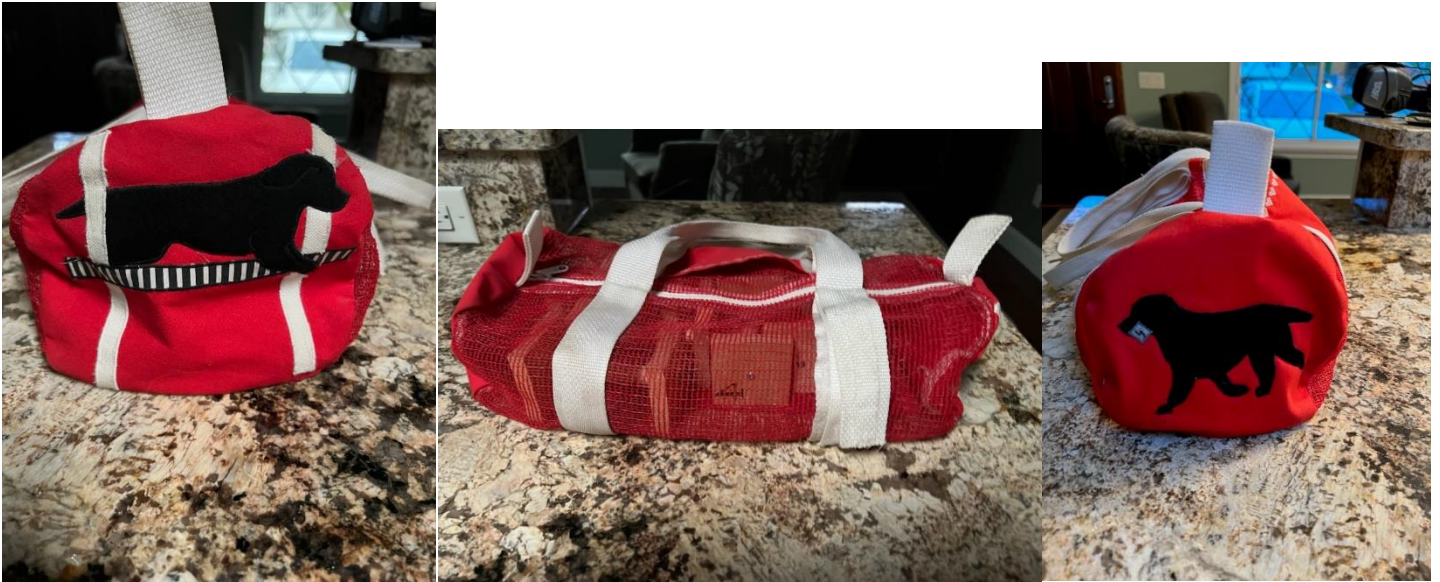

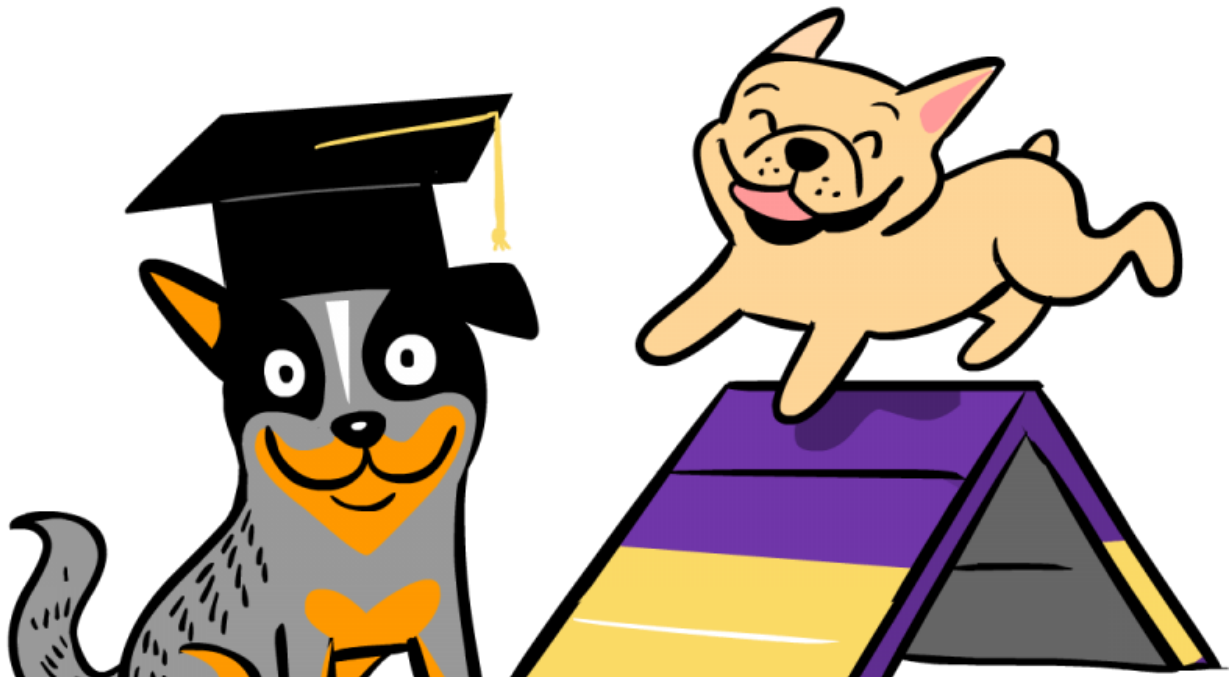
### Help A Girl Out?

She still plays in obedience after getting her UD and is working on tracking skills.

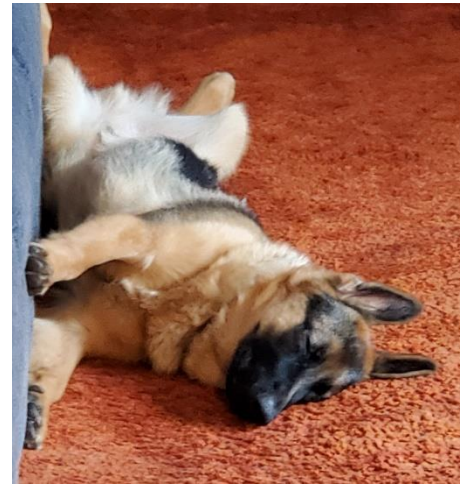
At home she claims the center of the bed and all of my heart! Proud to be her partner!

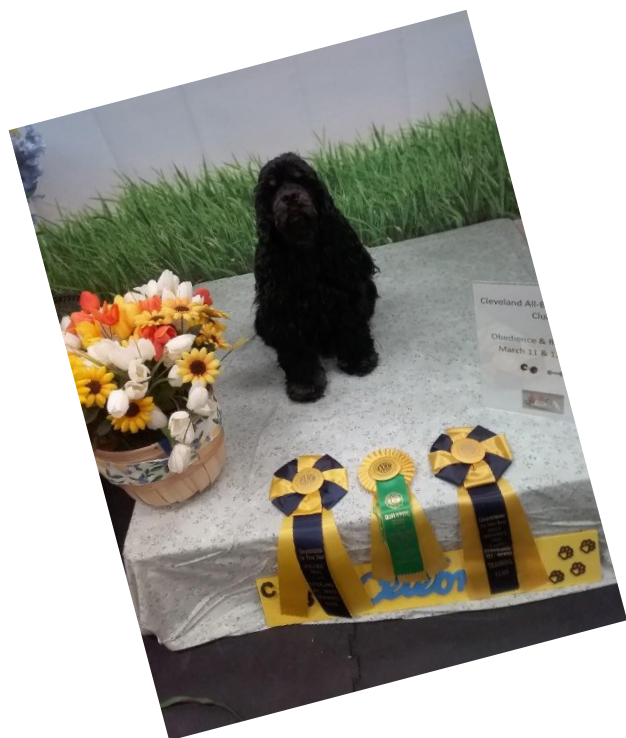

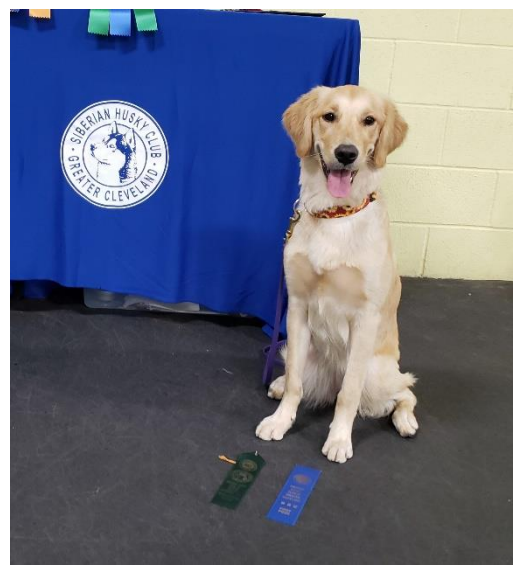
