More importantly, your understanding of the "how's" and "why's" will be clarified to make you a more effective trainer. Tony will work with 12 teams. Working spots are geared toward dogs that have succeeded with the AKC Excellent levels or above. Auditor spots will be limited; the quantity will be determined once working spots have been confirmed.

WORKING SPOTS:

A handler may only work one dog per Working Spot.

Crating will be in the car in the facility's parking log. Working dogs should be comfortable (& non-disruptive) while waiting for their turn. The handler should expect to work out of his or her car and stage away from the search areas, so you may not be able to watch other working teams. Please consider this when deciding whether to apply for a Working Spot.

Working Spots are limited — applying for a Working Spot does not guarantee acceptance. In the event of cancellations, preference for Working Spots will be given to those on the Wait List and then to those registered for Auditing Spots.

AUDITING SPOTS:
